The GNR has the task of ensuring the operation of an operational unit for research and collection of criminal information (UIC)



Control operations are effective means of preventing and combating crime related to the consumption of alcohol, drugs, transit of people, goods and vehicles that circulate illegally in the country and in the EU itself.

As a complement, police raids play a notorious role in civil security, often linked to a deep investigative work carried out by the Criminal Investigation Units (UIC), later complemented by the various GNR units.
