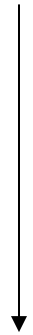
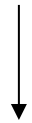
WHAT IS CITIZEN SECURITY?



Citizen security is the action developed by the State, in collaboration with citizens, aimed at ensuring their peaceful coexistence, the eradication of violence and the peaceful use of public roads and spaces, as well as contributing to the prevention of the commission of crimes and misdemeanors.



CITIZEN SECURITY OBJECTIVES

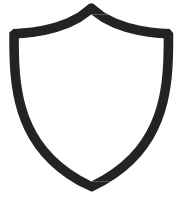

The purpose of citizen security is to protect the free exercise of the rights and freedoms of citizens.

The fulfillment and respect of individual and social guarantees at the national level.



RISK FACTORS

Risk factors are understood as those individual, family, school or social situations that increase the likelihood of people developing violent or criminal behavior.

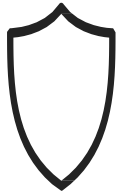


What is citizen security like in Spain?

Safe and unsafe cities in Spain

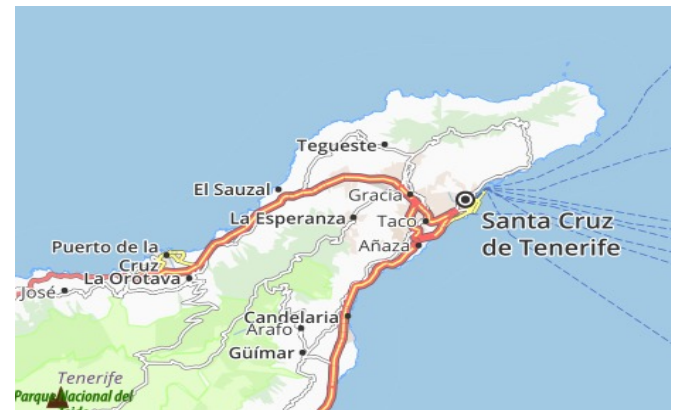
Safe cities

Unsafe cities

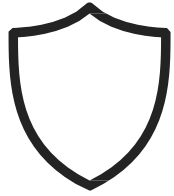
Among the most insecure cities we find in first position the city of Barcelona, in the second position, we find the city of Torrevieja, and in the third position we highlight Marbella.

Factors that improve citizen safety in a city



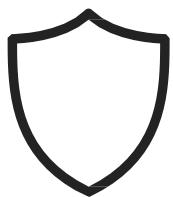
- Good
