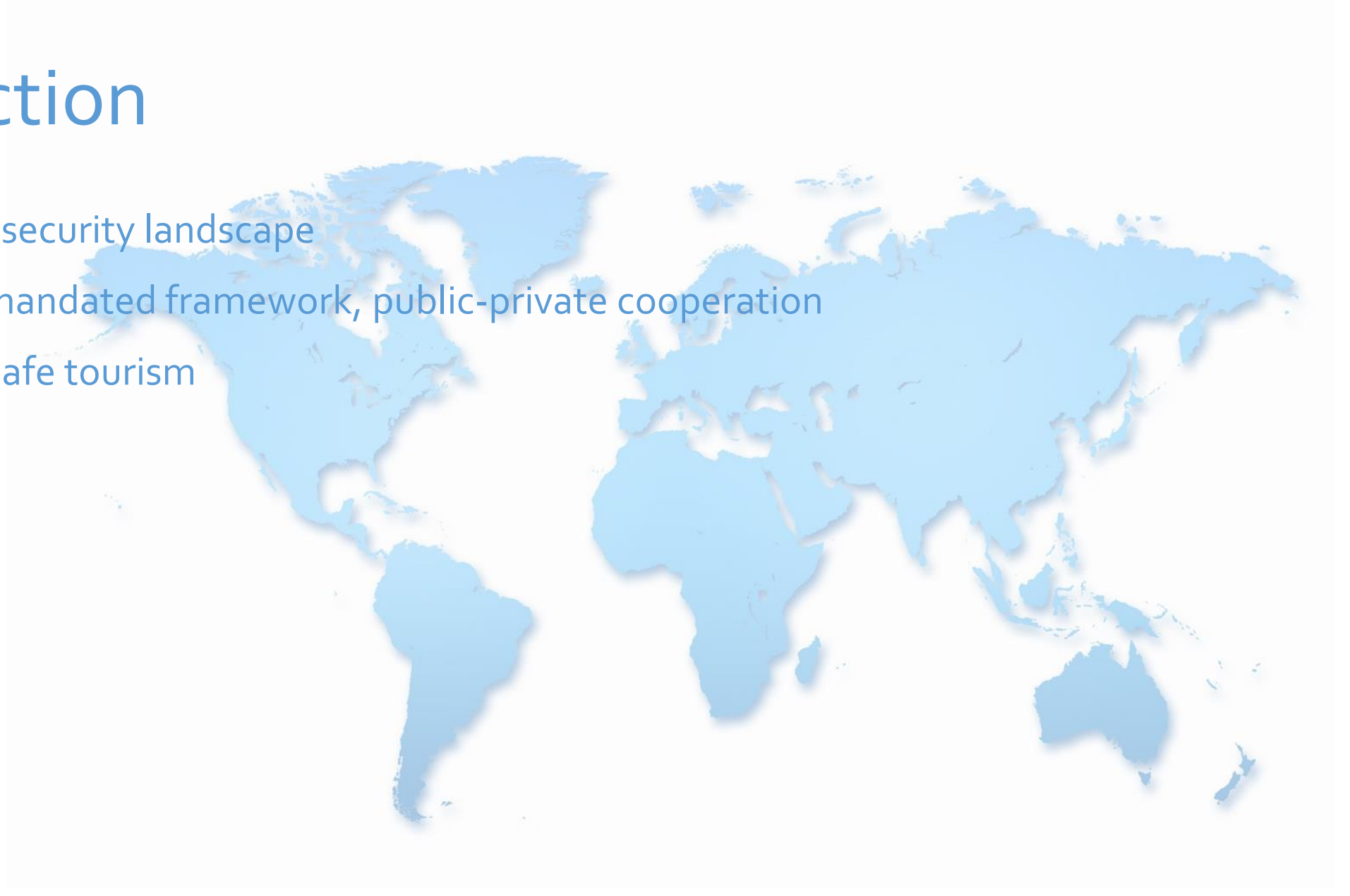

- Relevance of safe tourism



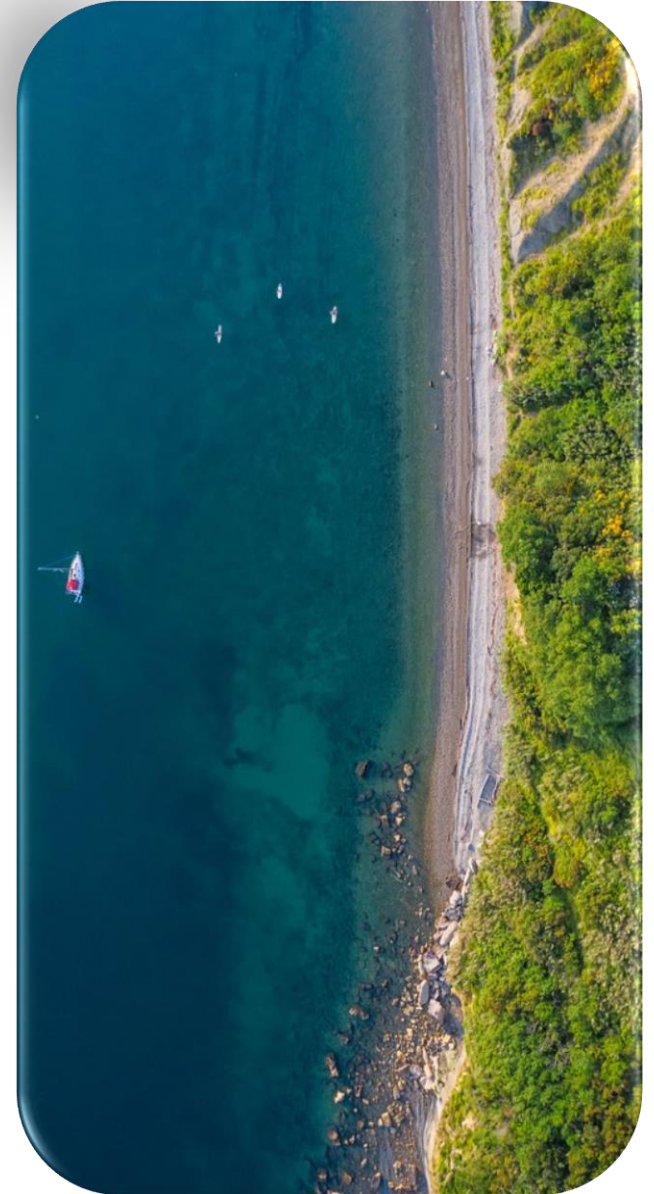
# Tourism
