- A complex phenomenon where its definition depends on various factors such as ideology, culture and moral values
- One of the most widespread, but often hidden, forms of human rights violations


- insults shouting,

- economic exploitation,

- forced prostitution,
- human trafficking,
- concealment of women for the purpose of exploitation,
- sexual exploitation,
- violation of reproductive rights,
- violence in armed conflicts



- False assumption: sex is always consensual in partnerships and marriages
- Economic violence: controlling and limiting a woman's financial resources
- Human trafficking: forced prostitution, forced labor, begging, servitude, forced marriages
- Perpetrators are most often men
- A key measure for states in the fight against violence in intimate partner relationships is to punish perpetrators





OPINION AND DEBATE

- Violence against women and the elderly is often ignored or underestimated in modern society
- Violence is unevenly distributed between the sexes
- Social isolation is a major problem for older people in terms of violence
- The dilemma of women facing violence: where to go, how to take care of their children, and how to survive?





- Raising awareness among the general public through campaigns
- Shortage of trained staff
- The important role of laws in protecting the victim
- Emphasis on preventive measures
