 - the first non-governmental organisation in Slovenia with programs for victims of violence as well as for perpetrators of violence.

OUR MAIN OBJECTIVES ARE


1. To reduce society's tolerance of violence.
2. To help those who experience violence.
3. To help those who commit violence to change their behaviour.

BASIC PRINCIPLES OF OUR WORK:

1. Everyone should work towards preventing violence and increasing the safety of victims
2. A person who commits violence is the only one to be held responsible.
3. Violence is a learned behaviour. Everyone can learn how to communicate in a nonviolent manner.

OUR PROGRAMS FOR VICTIMS

- helpline for information and counselling in the field of violence,
- information and counselling support through electronic and regular mail,
- individual counselling for victims of violence,
- social advocacy for victims of violence,
- accompaniment for victims of violence,
- safe house for women and children - victims of violence and safe accommodations,
- workshops for victims of violence.

- guided self – help group for victims of violence,
 - counselling for victims of sexual abuse,
 - individual help for children and youth who have experienced violence:
a regular gathering with a trained volunteer,
 - individual counselling.

PROGRAMS FOR PEOPLE WHO COMMIT VIOLENCE

- social skills training for people who commit violence
 - a group for men who commit violence against women (24 meetings, once weekly and several individual counselling sessions),
 - individual counselling for men and adolescents who commit violence,
- parenting skills training (24 weekly meetings),
- individual counselling for people who commit violence.

AND ALSO

- workshops for victims of violence:
 - preventive workshops,
 - intervention workshops,
- educational activities (lectures, conferences and seminars, expert consultations and discussions...),
- activism and cooperation with the media,
- publishing.

All the programs for victims and perpetrators are free on charge, as they are financed with funds received on public tenders.

OUR EMPLOYEES AND VOLUNTEERS

- most of our employees started working with us as volunteers,
- they come from different profesional backgrounds: social work, social pedagogy, psychology, students of Faculty of Criminal Justice and Security,
- they have received an intensive training in the field of violence prevention and intervention,
- regular supervision and intervision.

FINANCING

- our main sources of financing are obtained through public tenders by Ministry of Labour, Family, social Affairs and Equal Opportunities,
- local Communities,
- FIHO (Foundation for Financing Humanitarian and Disability Organisation,
- donations.

We also participate in different projects, financed by European Union funds.
