Before "Safety and security in local communities" (2015-2018) and (2019-2024)

Crime prevention Western Style – post doc – Institute of Criminology, University of Cambridge, UK (2001) – emphasis on local/community crime prevention.

National criminological conference – Crime prevention – theory, practice and dilemmas (2003) – local perspectives matter!

Council of Europe (2002-2004) Prevention of everyday violence in a democratic society (also visited Stockholm – witness/victim coaching programmes for gang members).

Membership in the **EUCPN – European Crime Prevention Network** – 2018 – Austria – community policing and 2022 – prevention of peer violence in schools. Tools for crime prevention.

Research on distribution of deviance in Ljubljana (GIS) (2004); **local safety councils and community policing** (2005), Fear of crime and local safety (2010-2012).

Local crime prevention (Beccaria centre for crime prevention, Hannover), a partner (2005-2008). Focus on urban municipalities.

GERN – CRIMPREV (2006-2009) Assessing deviance, crime and prevention in Europe. Catching up with the best & and networking with other research institutions.

2009-2011 – Drafting a national crime prevention programme – adopted in 2011.

Urban security manager – EEMZS/EFUS (MA programme) (2010-2012). Focus on urban municipalities – **capital cities** of republics of former Yugoslavia.

URBIS – urban security management – towards a professional PhD programme (2012-2014). Focus on urban municipalities. Focus on urban municipalities – **capital cities** of republics of former Yugoslavia.

Fear of crime in capitals of former Yugoslav republics (2012). Focus on urban municipalities – a comparison of former **capital cities** of republics of former Yugoslavia.

Legitimacy of policing, CJS and execution of penal sanctions (2013-2016). Focus on urban municipalities. Young people and their perception of police legitimacy and trust in police (Ljubljana & Maribor), also Central, Eastern and Western Europe.
