Fakulteta za varnostne vede Univerze v Mariboru je edina visokošolska institucija s področja varstvoslovja v Republiki Sloveniji. Začetki fakultete segajo v leto 1973, ko se je pričel višešolski študij s področja notranjih zadev. ADDRESS BY THE DEAN

Faculty of Criminal Justice and Security, University of Maribor, is the only higher-education institution in Slovenia that specializes in criminal justice and security. The beginnings of the faculty date back to 1973, when the academic programme in internal affairs was established. Since then, we have developed into a full-fledged institution with programmes at the bachelor's, master's, and doctoral level, a strong integration to international educational and research environment, and the ambition to become a European educational and research centre of excellence in criminal justice and security. The interdisciplinary and multidisciplinary nature of this field derives from extremely complex processes aimed at ensuring security in today's world. Our products and services are offered to state bodies in internal affairs, defence, civil protection and disaster relief, criminal justice and local government, and increasingly to the private sector.

The academic programmes are internationally comparable and constantly improved in line with the needs of security organizations and the findings of our research projects. Up-to-date and interesting programmes are complemented by lectures delivered by heads and other representatives of the most important agencies for ensuring security and social control in Slovenia. We have established close partnerships with more than forty higher-education institutions abroad, and have ensured vibrant mobility of students and professors, as well as participation in research projects.

passion for research, discovering new skills, and solving current problems in ensuring security. We promise our students that we will dedicate as much time as possible to them and teach them a lot—in particular, how they can learn on their own and how they can apply this knowledge in practice—that we will educate them in academic values, and that in difficult times they will never be left alone. However, students are key in this, and so we expect them to work with us and create a partner relationship, to be engaged and come up with their own ideas and suggestions, to be ready to do everything to achieve them, to be motivated and persistent, to promote a high level of personal integrity, dignity, and academic honesty, and, after graduating, to never forget who they are, where they come from, and what their alma mater is. UNIVERZA V MARIBORU

Univerza v Mariboru je druga največja in druga najstarejša univerza v Sloveniji. Na njej študira približno 14.000 študentov. Je avtonomna znanstveno-raziskovalna in izobraževalna ustanova, katere namen je odkrivanje znanja, skrb za znanje ter prenašanje znanja skozi vsepovezanost humanistike, družboslovja, tehnike, ekonomije, medicine, naravoslovja, prava, pedagoških ved in umetnosti v širšo družbeno skupnost. Izvedba študijskih programov po kreditnem sistemu (ECTS) omogoča študij na matičnih fakultetah in hkrati izbiro predmetov na drugih študijskih programih v okviru UM in drugih slovenskih visokošolskih ustanovah (nacionalna mobilnost) ter študij v tujini (mednarodna mobilnost).



UNIVERSITY OF MARIBOR

The University of Maribor is the second-largest and the second-oldest university in Slovenia, and it has a student body numbering about 14,000. It is an autonomous research and educational institution dedicated to discovering, cultivating, and transferring knowledge through the interconnection of the humanities, the social sciences, technology, economics, medicine, the natural sciences, law, education, and art into the wider community. The University of Maribor focuses on attracting the best students and creating a developing environment where excellence is at home in all respects. It is becoming a central development institution that is connected with the business world and, together with its partners, creates a sustainable development center for the wider region.

The University of Maribor consists of seventeen faculties, the University of Maribor Library, and the Student Residence Halls. The faculties offer undergraduate and graduate programmes in Maribor, Ljubljana, Kranj, Celje, Krško, Brežice, Hoče, and Velenje. Carrying out the programmes in line with the European Credit Transfer and Accumulation System (ECTS) allows students to study at their home faculty and at the same time select courses in other programmes within the University of Maribor and other Slovenian higher-education institutions (national mobility) and abroad (international mobility).

FAKULTETA ZA VARNOSTNE VEDE

Fakulteta za varnostne vede, članica Univerze v Mariboru, je vodilna izobraževalna in znanstveno-raziskovalna institucija s področja varstvoslovja v Sloveniji. Za začetek delovanja fakultete štejemo leto 1973, ko so na Višji upravni šoli v Ljubljani ustanovili Oddelek za notranje zadeve. Leta 1981 je Republiški sekretariat za notranje zadeve SRS ustanovil Višjo šolo za notranje zadeve v Ljubljani. Istega leta je šola postala članica Univerze v Ljubljani, kasneje pa dolga leta njena pridružena članica. Leta 1996 se je preimenovala v Visoko policijsko-varnostno šolo. Leta 2003 se je preoblikovala v Fakulteto za policijsko-varnostne vede in postala polnopravna članica Univerze v Mariboru. Sedanje ime – Fakulteta za varnostne vede – je dobila leta 2006.

Fakulteta se že več kot štiri desetletja ukvarja z izobraževanjem in raziskovanjem na področju varstvoslovja. Na fakulteti izvajamo tri študijske programe 1. stopnje, en študijski program 2. stopnje in en študijski program 3. stopnje.



FACULTY OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE AND SECURITY

The Faculty of Criminal Justice and Security, a member institution of the University of Maribor, is the leading educational and research institution in criminal justice and security in Slovenia. The beginnings of the Faculty of Criminal Justice and Security go back to 1973, when the College of Public Administration in Ljubljana established a department to offer programmes in internal affairs. In 1981, the Slovenian National Secretariat for Interior Affairs established the College of Internal Affairs in Ljubljana. That same year, the school became a member institution of the University of Ljubljana, and later an associate member for many years. In 1996, the school was renamed the College of Police and Security Studies. In 2003 it was renamed the Faculty of Police and Security Studies and became a full member of the University of Maribor. Its current name—the Faculty of Criminal Justice and Security—was adopted in 2006. For more than four decades, the faculty has been engaged in education and research in criminal justice and security. The faculty offers three bachelor's programmes, one master's programme, and one doctoral programme.

WHAT IS CRIMINAL JUSTICE AND SECURITY?

Criminal Justice and Security (Slovene: varstvoslovje, from varstvo 'security' + slovje 'studies') is an interdisciplinary science that examines the phenomenon of safety and security, develops and studies mechanisms developed by society to ensure the safety and security of the state, local communities, companies and individuals against behaviour that can harm the individual, community, and/or country, and develops theories and methods in criminal justice and security.

VISOKOŠOLSKI STROKOVNI PROGRAM VARNOST IN POLICIJSKO DELO

Visokošolski strokovni program Varnost in policijsko delo razvija sposobnosti diplomantov za samostojno delo in kritičnost na področju varstvoslovja. Diplomirani varstvoslovci visokošolskega strokovnega programa imajo teoretična in praktična znanja za izvajanje zahtevnih strokovnih opravil na področju zagotavljanja varnosti in za vodenje varnostnih organizacij.



VISOKOŠOLSKI STROKOVNI PROGRAM INFORMACIJSKA VARNOST

Visokošolski strokovni program Informacijska varnost razvija sposobnosti diplomantov za samostojno delo in kritičnost na področju informacijske varnosti. Diplomirani varstvoslovci informacijske varnosti so teoretično in praktično usposobljeni za izvajanje strokovnih, razvojnih in vodstvenih opravil na področjih informatike, informacijskih sistemov in varstvoslovja, predvsem z vidika mehanizmov zagotavljanja varnosti v informacijski družbi.

UNIVERZITETNI ŠTUDIJSKI PROGRAM VARSTVOSLOVJE

Univerzitetni študijski program Varstvoslovje je raziskovalno usmerjen in poleg posredovanja ustreznih znanj razvija tudi sposobnosti diplomantov za samostojno strokovno delo, kritičnost ter analitičen, ustvarjalen in inovativen pristop k reševanju problemov. Univerzitetni diplomirani varstvoslovci so usposobljeni za prenos in uporabo teoretičnega znanja v praksu ter reševanje strokovnih delovnih problemov, zlasti z iskanjem novih virov znanja in uporabo metod za razumevanje, vodenje in upravljanje zahtevnejših procesov na področju zagotavljanja varnosti. Še posebej so opremljeni z znanji, potrebnimi za nadaljevanje študija na magistrskem programu.

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UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMMES

The basic goal of the undergraduate (first-cycle) Bologna programmes at the Faculty of Criminal Justice and Security is to provide relevant knowledge and develop graduates' ability to work independently, with a critical, analytical, creative, and innovative approach to solving security problems.

PROFESSIONAL STUDIES BA IN INFORMATION SECURITY

The applied bachelor's programme Information Security develops students' ability to work independently in information security. Students receive theoretical and practical training to carry out professional, developmental, and managerial tasks in information technology, information systems, and criminal justice and security, particularly in terms of mechanisms for ensuring security in the information society.

BA IN CRIMINAL JUSTICE AND SECURITY

The bachelor's programme Criminal Justice and Security is research oriented and, in addition to providing relevant knowledge, it also develops students' skills for independent professional work, a criticality perspective, and an analytical, creative, and innovative problem-solving approach. Students are trained to transfer and apply theoretical knowledge in practice and to solve professional problems, in particular by looking for new sources of knowledge and using methods to understand, manage, and administer complex processes in security assurance. They are especially equipped with the skills necessary to continue their education at the master's level.



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MAGISTRSKI ŠTUDIJSKI PROGRAM VARSTVOSLOVJE

Magistrski študijski program Varstvoslovje je program druge bolonjske stopnje, ki spodbuja interdisciplinarno izobraževanje, raziskovanje in mednarodno sodelovanje v okviru treh modulov: Kriminologija in kriminalistika, Korporativna varnost in Informacijska varnost. Cilj magistrskega študija je izobraziti strokovnjake z znanjem s širšega področja varstvoslovja in dobim razumevanjem družbene realnosti, trendov na področju izvajanja nadzorstvenih dejavnosti ter delovanja institucij formalnega in neformalnega družbenega nadzorstva. Magistri varstvoslovja so usposobljeni za prevemanje najzahtevnejših nalog pri analiziranju, vrednotenju, načrtovanju, oblikovanju, razvoju in vodenju varnostnih procesov v javnih organizacijah na državni in lokalni ravni, v nevladnih, zasebnih (gospodarskih) organizacijah ter za delo na akademskem področju.

**DOKTORSKI
ŠTUDIJSKI PROGRAM
VARSTVOSLOVJE**

Doktorski študijski program Varstvoslovje je program tretje bolonjske stopnje, usmerjen k individualiziranemu znanstveno-raziskovalnemu delu na področju varstvoslovja. Študij in raziskovanje potekata v okviru sedmih osnovnih področij: kriminologija, policijska dejavnost, kriminalistika, varnostne vede, informacijska varnost, forenzična psihologija in pravni vidiki formalnega družbenega nadzorstva. Ključna je usmerjenost doktorskega študenta v določen raziskovalni problem znotraj omenjenih področij, pri čemer je program znan po svoji interdisciplinarnosti. Tako študenti že od vsega začetka tesno sodelujejo z mentorji in somentorji, ki jih vodijo in usmerjajo pri raziskovanju. Doktorji znanosti s področja varstvoslovja so usposobljeni za striktno uporabo ustreznega znanstveno-raziskovalnega instrumentarija za razvijanje novega znanja, ki naj prispeva k reševanju kompleksnih varnostnih in drugih problemov v družbi. Hkrati so opolnomočeni za opravljanje najzahtevnejših nalog v javnem in zasebnem sektorju, s poudarkom na zakonitosti, osebni odgovornosti, etiki in integriteti.

MA IN CRIMINAL JUSTICE AND SECURITY

The master's programme Criminal Justice and Security is a second-cycle Bologna programme that promotes interdisciplinary education, research, and international cooperation in three modules: Criminology and Criminal Justice, Corporate Security, and Information Security. The aim of the master's programme is to educate experts with broad knowledge of criminal justice and security and a sound understanding of social reality, trends in carrying out supervisory activities, and the functioning of institutions of formal and informal social control. Students are qualified to perform the most demanding tasks in analysing, evaluating, planning, designing, developing, and managing security processes in public organizations at the national and local levels and in non-governmental, private (business) organizations, as well as for work in academia.

**PhD IN CRIMINAL
JUSTICE AND SECURITY**

The doctoral programme Criminal Justice and Security is a third-cycle Bologna programme oriented toward individualized research in criminal justice and security. The programme and research activities take place in seven basic fields: criminology, policing, criminal investigation, security studies, information security, forensic psychology, and legal aspects of formal social control. The doctoral student's orientation toward a particular research problem within these areas is crucial, whereby the programme is known for its interdisciplinarity. From the very beginning, students work closely with their supervisors, who lead and guide them in the research. Doctoral students in criminal justice and security are trained to strictly use appropriate research instruments to develop new knowledge that should contribute to solving complex security issues and other problems in society. At the same time, they are empowered to carry out the most demanding tasks in the public and private sector, with an emphasis on legality, personal responsibility, ethics, and integrity.

MEDNARODNO SODELOVANJE

Fakulteta za varnostne vede tesno sodeluje s številnimi tujimi univerzami in inštituti. V evropskih državah imamo podpisanih 42 sporazumov, ki omogočajo mobilnost študentov in zaposlenih v okviru programa Erasmus+ oziroma programa švicarske mobilnosti, ter vzpostavljeno aktivno bilateralno sodelovanje s sorodnimi institucijami v državah z območja nekdanje Jugoslavije.

Dobro razvita mreža partnerskih institucij omogoča fakulteti aktivno sodelovanje v programih študentske mobilnosti. V obdobju med letoma 2006 in 2018 smo v sklopu teh programov gostili več kot 170 tujih študentov, ki so semester ali dva preživeli na FVV, približno enako število študentov FVV pa je del svojih obveznosti opravilo v tujini. V okviru programa Erasmus+ vsako leto gostimo od 20 do 25 tujih študentov, ki lahko za opravljanje svojih študijskih obveznosti na FVV izbirajo med več kot 40 predmeti v angleškem jeziku. Naši študenti se lahko udeležijo mobilnosti v tujini tudi s ciljem izdelave zaključnega dela ali v okviru Erasmus+ programa za usposabljanje. Poleg omenjenih mobilnosti je vsako leto na rednem in izrednem študiju FVV vpisanih okrog 20 tujih študentov.

Profesorji in raziskovalci FVV svoje pedagoško in raziskovalno delo redno izvajajo tudi na sorodnih institucijah v tujini. Njihova mednarodna mobilnost vključuje tedenska, mesečna in večmesečna gostovanja, krajsa gostovanja z namenom usposabljanja pa so omogočena tudi strokovnim delavcem fakultete. Na fakulteti redno gostimo ugledne tujje profesorje, raziskovalce in strokovnjake iz prakse.

INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION



The Faculty of Criminal Justice and Security works closely with many foreign universities and institutes. In Europe, we have signed forty-two agreements that allow student and employee mobility under the Erasmus+ programme or the Swiss mobility programme, as well as active bilateral cooperation with similar institutions in other countries of the former Yugoslavia.

A well-developed network of partner institutions allows the Faculty of Criminal Justice and Security to actively participate in student mobility programmes. Between 2006 and 2018, as part of these programmes, more than 170 foreign students were hosted by the faculty and spent one or two semesters there, and about the same number of students from the faculty fulfilled part of their academic requirements abroad. As part of the Erasmus+ programme, we annually host twenty to twenty-five foreign students, who can choose among forty courses taught in English to pursue their academic requirements at the faculty. Our students can also participate in mobility abroad with the aim of finishing their thesis or within the Erasmus+ training programme. In addition to this mobility, about twenty foreign students are enrolled each year in full-time and part-time programmes at the faculty.

Professors and researchers at the faculty regularly perform teaching and research work at similar institutions abroad. Their international mobility includes visits lasting a week, a month, or several months, and shorter training visits are also provided to the faculty's staff. The Faculty of Criminal Justice and Security regularly hosts prominent professors, researchers, and experts in the field from abroad.

INŠTITUT ZA VARSTVOSLOVJE

Na Fakulteti za varnostne vede deluje tudi Inštitut za varstvoslovje, v okviru katerega poteka sodobno varstvoslovno raziskovanje. Varstvoslovno raziskovanje vključuje preučevanje in razvijanje teorij, struktur, postopkov, vzrokov in posledic družbenega odzivanja na kriminalitetu in prestopništvo ter preučevanje drugih varnostnih pojavov. V okviru inštituta izvajamo temeljne, aplikativne, razvojne in druge projekte ter opravljamo strokovne, svetovalne in druge storitve, ki sodijo v nacionalni program raziskovalnega dela. Raziskovalno delo na Fakulteti za varnostne vede je podprtjo tudi z ustreznou infrastrukturom s področja geografskega informacijskega sistema (GIS), kriminalistike in forenzike ter informacijske varnosti.



INSTITUTE OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE AND SECURITY

The Institute of Criminal Justice and Security operates at the Faculty of Criminal Justice and Security, within which contemporary research in criminal justice and security is carried out. Criminal justice and security research includes the study and development of theories, structures, procedures, causes, and consequences of society's response to crime and delinquency, and the study of other security phenomena. In the framework of the institute we implement basic, applied, developmental, and other projects, and we provide professional, consulting, and other services that fall under the national research programme. Research work at the Faculty of Criminal Justice and Security is also supported by proper infrastructure in geographic information systems (GIS), criminal investigation, forensics, and information security.

RAZISKOVALNI PROJEKTI

Na Fakulteti za varnostne vede pedagoško in raziskovalno dejavnost razumemo kot enakovredna procesa, skozi katera dosegamo sinergijske učinke.



Leta 2015 je fakulteta pridobila programsko skupino Varnost v lokalnih skupnostih, v okviru katere izvaja raziskovalni program področja zagotavljanja varnosti na lokalni ravni.

Naši raziskovalci ugotovitve in rezultate svojega raziskovalnega dela redno objavljajo v uglednih domačih in tujih znanstvenih revijah ter se kot priznani vrhunski strokovnjaki s področja varnostnih ved udeležujejo številnih domačih in tujih znanstvenih srečanj. Naši zaposleni so aktivni tudi v domačih in mednarodnih znanstvenih ter strokovnih združenjih. Fakulteta gradi uspešno in povezano akademsko skupnost s prenosom raziskovalnih spoznanj v pedagoški proces, z dostopom do globalnih znanstvenih in strokovnih virov ter s sodelovanjem pri oblikovanju sektorskih politik.



RESEARCH PROJECTS

At the Faculty of Criminal Justice and Security, teaching and research are understood as two equal processes that create synergistic effects.

In 2015, the faculty acquired a research programme group Security and Safety in Local Communities, within which it carries out a research programme in ensuring security at the local level.

Our researchers regularly publish the findings and results of their research in prominent national and international journals, and as leading experts in criminal justice and security they participate in numerous conferences in Slovenia and abroad. Our employees are also active in domestic and international research and professional associations. The faculty builds a successful and integrated academic community by transferring research findings into teaching, accessing global research and professional resources, and participating in shaping sectoral policies.

KNJIŽNICA

Knjižnica Fakultete za varnostne vede pridobiva, strokovno obdeluje, hrani in zagotavlja dostop do gradiva s širšega področja varstvoslovja in sorodnih ved ter s tem nudi pomembno podporo pedagoškemu in raziskovalnemu delu na fakulteti. Knjižnica sodeluje s sorodnimi visokošolskimi in specjalnimi knjižnicami. Pri zagotavljanju storitev za uporabnike je še posebej pomembno povezovanje z Univerzitetno knjižnico Maribor ter ostalimi knjižnicami članic Univerze v Mariboru, saj le te svojim uporabnikom skupaj zagotavljajo dostop do velikega števila domačih in tujih elektronskih informacijskih virov. Knjižnica izvaja tudi informacijsko opismenjevanje študentov in je vključena v procese založniške dejavnosti na fakulteti.



LIBRARY

The library of the Faculty of Criminal Justice and Security acquires, professionally processes, stores, and provides access to materials from the wider field of criminal justice and security and related sciences, and thus provides important support for teaching and research work at the faculty. The library cooperates with related higher-education and specialized libraries. In ensuring services to users, it is of crucial importance to be connected with the University of Maribor Library and libraries of other faculties of University od Maribor, which together provide their users with access to a large number of Slovenian and foreign electronic information sources. The library also offers information literacy for students and is involved in publishing activities at the faculty.

DOGAJANJA NA FAKULTETI

Na Fakulteti za varnostne vede potekajo tudi bogata konferenčna dejavnost in drugi strokovni dogodki. Med tradicionalne konference štejemo:

- osrednja nacionalna konferenca s področja varnosti Dnevi varstvoslovja,
- mednarodna bienalna konferenca Criminal Justice and Security in Central and Eastern Europe,
- posvet s področja kriminalističnega preiskovanja,
- konferenca s področja informacijske varnosti.

Večkrat na leto pa so organizirane tudi Kriminalistične srede, strokovna srečanja, namenjena strokovni pa tudi laični javnosti.



EVENTS AT THE FACULTY

At the Faculty of Criminal Justice and Security, rich conference activity and other professional events take place. Our traditional conferences are:

- The central national security conference Criminal Justice and Security Days;
- The international biennial conference Criminal Justice and Security in Central and Eastern Europe;
- A consultation session on criminal investigation; and
- A conference on information security.

Several times a year, Criminal Investigation Wednesdays and meetings for the professional community and general public are also held.





SLOVENIJA

Republika Slovenija obsega 20.271 km² površine, ki jo poseljujeta dobra dva milijona prebivalcev, med katerimi so večinoma Slovenci, priznani pa sta tudi dve avtohtoni nacionalni manjšini – italijanska in madžarska narodna skupnost. Od leta 2004 je Slovenija članica Evropske unije in Nata, plačilno sredstvo pa je evro. Na njenem ozemlju se stikajo štiri velika geografska območja: Alpe, Panonska nižina, Dinarsko gorstvo in Sredozemlje. Več kot polovico Slovenije pokriva gozd, kar jo uvršča na tretje mesto med najbolj gozdnatimi državami v Evropi. Približno 14 odstotkov njenega ozemlja je zavarovanega. Najpomembnejša zavarovana območja so Triglavski narodni park, Škocjanske jame, Sečoveljske soline, Cerkniško jezero in Škocjanski zatok. Naravne danosti, prijazni prebivalci, mirno in varno okolje privabijo v Slovenijo vsako leto več obiskovalcev iz tujine. Razdalje med kraji so kratke, cestna infrastruktura pa razvita, kar omogoča ogled pestre palete naravnih, kulturnih, arhitekturnih, etnografskih in drugih znamenitosti in značilnosti v relativno kratkem času.



SLOVENIA

Slovenia has an area of 20,271 km² with a population of just over two million, most of whom are ethnic Slovenians, and two autochthonous ethnic minorities are also recognized: the Italian and Hungarian communities. Since 2004, Slovenia has been a member of the European Union and NATO, and its currency is the euro. Four large geographical areas meet in Slovenian territory: the Alps, the Pannonian Basin, the Dinaric Alps, and the Mediterranean. More than half of Slovenia is covered by forest, which places it in third place among the most forested countries in Europe. Approximately fourteen percent of its territory is protected, and among the most important protected areas are Triglav National Park, Škocjan Caves, the Sečovlje Salt Pans, Lake Cerknica, and the Škocjan Lagoon Nature Reserve. Natural conditions, friendly people, and a peaceful and safe environment attract growing visitors from abroad each year. The distance between the towns is short and the road infrastructure is well developed, which allows visitors to see a wide range of natural, cultural, architectural, ethnographic, and other sights and features in a relatively short time.





LJUBLJANA

Ljubljana je glavno in s približno 288.000 prebivalci tudi največje mesto v Sloveniji. Po številu prebivalcev se uvršča med srednje velika evropska mesta. Ob tem, ko ohranja toplino in prijaznost, tako značilni za manjše kraje, ima vse, kar premorejo velike prestolnice – je politično, gospodarsko, kulturno, izobraževalno in znanstveno središče Slovenije ter pomembno trgovsko, poslovno, kongresno in sejemske mesto na stičišču Srednje in Jugovzhodne Evrope. Ljubljana je mesto različnih kultur in zgodovinskih dogajanj. Njena podoba je slikovita, poseben čar mestu pa dajejo številne zelene površine, zaradi katerih Ljubljano uvrščajo med najbolj zelenega mesta v Evropi. Staro mestno jedro krasí izjemna arhitektura, ki so jo zaznamovala različna zgodovinska obdobja, še najbolj pa barok. Poseben pečat je mestu vtisnil znameniti arhitekt Jože Plečnik (1872–1957). Ljubljana nudi številne kulturne in umetniške dogodke. Koncerti, festivali, gledališke predstave, operni in baletni program, ulično gledališče, sejmi in različne razstave gostijo priznane domače in tujne umetnike.



LJUBLJANA

Ljubljana is Slovenia's capital and, with a population of approximately 288,000, it is also the country's largest city. In terms of population, it is a medium-sized European city. While maintaining the warmth and friendliness typical of smaller towns, it has everything that large capitals possess: it is the political, economic, cultural, educational, and research centre of Slovenia, and an important trade, business, congress, and trade fair city at the intersection of central and southeast Europe. Ljubljana is a city of various cultures and historical events. Its character is picturesque, and a special charm of the city is its many green spaces, which make Ljubljana one of the greenest cities in Europe. The old city centre is graced with exceptional architecture, which is marked by various historical periods, most notably the Baroque. The renowned architect Jože Plečnik (1872–1957) added a special touch to the city. Ljubljana offers numerous cultural and artistic events. Concerts, festivals, theatre performances, an opera and ballet programme, street theatre, fairs, and various exhibitions host renowned national and international artists.
