Fakulteta za varnostne vede Univerze v Mariboru je edina visokošolska institucija s področja varstvoslovja v Republiki Sloveniji. The Faculty of Criminal Justice and Security at the University of Maribor is the only higher education institution in Slovenia to offer programmes in the field of security studies. Over the past fifty years we have educated a considerable number of professionals in the security field whose knowledge and experience make a significant contribution to the safety and stability of our society.

Ever since our founding we have been committed to providing our students with the knowledge, skills and practical experience necessary for their work in security. The beginnings of the Faculty date back to 1973 and the introduction of higher education in the field of internal affairs. Since then we have developed into a well-established institution offering a range of undergraduate, postgraduate and doctoral programmes, solidly integrated in the international education and research sphere and with the ambition to become a European centre of excellence in security studies. The highly complex processes involved in modern security make security studies a multidisciplinary field. We provide expertise and services to state bodies operating in the fields of internal affairs, defence, protection and rescue and criminal justice, and also to local government bodies. Through the study of information security and hybrid threats, we are also increasingly present in the business sector. We are proud of our colleagues, who actively contribute to the development and progress of our Faculty with their knowledge and experience in the security field. They are dedicated to their work and are constantly supplementing their knowledge in order to be able to provide students with the best opportunities for success.

Our study programmes are internationally comparable and are constantly being updated in the light of the findings of research projects, current security challenges and evaluations, where students also play an important role. We also maintain close connections with numerous higher education institutions in Europe, the United States and Japan, in this way facilitating a high rate of student and teacher mobility and collaboration on research projects.

At the Faculty of Criminal Justice and Security we expect a high level of academic integrity, motivation, persistence and courage, combined with a passion for research, discovering new knowledge and addressing current problems in the field of security. We promise our students that we will educate them in academic values, give them our maximum attention and teach them many things – including how to acquire knowledge independently and apply that knowledge in practice. We also assure them that they will never be left alone when they are in difficulty. We firmly believe that successful education requires a partnership among professors, support staff and students. UNIVERZA V MARIBORU

Univerza v Mariboru, ustanovljena leta 1975, je druga največja in druga najstarejša univerza v Sloveniji. Na njej študira približno 14.100 študentov. Je avtonomna znanstvenoraziskovalna in izobraževalna ustanova, katere namen je odkrivanje znanja, skrb za znanje ter prenašanje znanja skozi vsepovezanost humanistike, družboslovja, tehnike, ekonomije, medicine, naravoslovja, prava, pedagoških ved in umetnosti v širšo družbeno skupnost. Univerza v Mariboru je usmerjena v privabljanje najboljših študentov in ustvarjanje razvojnega okolja, kjer je doma odličnost v vseh pogledih. Postaja osrednja razvojna institucija, ki se povezuje z gospodarstvom in skupaj s partnerji ustvarja center trajnostnega razvoja širše regije.

Univerzo v Mariboru sestavlja 17 fakultet, Univerzitetna knjižnica Maribor in Študentski domovi. Fakultete s svojimi dodiplomskimi in poddiplomskimi študijskimi programi pokrivajo naravoslovno-matematične, tehniške, medicinske, biotehniške, družboslovne in humanistične ter druge vede. Univerza v Mariboru je s svojimi članicami na 8 lokacijah po Sloveniji (v Mariboru, Ljubljani, Kranju, Celju, Krškem, Brežicah, Hočah in Velenju). Izvedba študijskih programov po kreditnem sistemu (ECTS) omogoča študij na matičnih fakultetah in hkrati izbiro predmetov na drugih študijskih programih v okviru UM in drugih slovenskih visokošolskih ustanovah (nacionalna mobilnost) ter študij v tujini (mednarodna mobilnost).



UNIVERSITY OF MARIBOR

The University of Maribor, established in 1975, is the second largest and second oldest university in Slovenia and has a student body numbering around 14,100. It is an autonomous research and educational institution dedicated to the discovery and cultivation of knowledge and its transfer into the wider community through the interconnection of the humanities, the social sciences, technology, economics, medicine, the natural sciences, law, education and the arts. The University of Maribor focuses on attracting the best students and creating a development environment that is home to excellence in all its aspects. It is becoming a key development institution that is forming connections with industry and, together with its partners, creating a centre of sustainable development for the wider region.

The University of Maribor consists of 17 faculties, Maribor University Library and the University of Maribor Student Dormitories. The faculties offer undergraduate and postgraduate programmes in the fields of mathematics, natural sciences, engineering, medicine, biotechnology, social sciences and the humanities, among others. Together with its member institutions, the University of Maribor is present in eight locations around Slovenia (Maribor, Ljubljana, Kranj, Celje, Krško, Brežice, Hoče and Velenje). The provision of study programmes under the European Credit Transfer and Accumulation System (ECTS) allows students to study at their main faculties and, at the same time, to choose courses in other programmes within the University of Maribor and other Slovenian higher education institutions (national mobility) and study abroad (international mobility).

FAKULTETA ZA VARNOSTNE VEDE

Fakulteta za varnostne vede Univerze v Mariboru je vodilna izobraževalna in znanstvenoraziskovalna institucija s področja varstvoslovja v Sloveniji. Za začetek delovanja fakultete štejemo leto 1973, ko so zaradi potreb takratnega Republiškega sekretariata za notranje zadeve SRS (RSNZ) na Višji upravni šoli v Ljubljani ustanovili Oddelek za notranje zadeve. Namesto tega oddelka je leta 1981 RSNZ ustanovil Višjo šolo za notranje zadeve v Ljubljani. Istega leta je šola postala članica Univerze v Ljubljani, kasneje pa dolga leta njena pridružena članica. Leta 1996 se je preimenovala v Visoko policijsko-varnostno šolo. Leta 2003 se je preoblikovala v Fakulteto za policijsko-varnostne vede in postala članica Univerze v Mariboru. Sedanje ime – Fakulteta za varnostne vede – je dobila leta 2006.

Fakulteta se že pet desetletij ukvarja z izobraževanjem in raziskovanjem na področju varstvoslovja. Na fakulteti izvajamo tri študijske programe 1. stopnje, en študijski program 2. stopnje in en študijski program 3. stopnje.





FACULTY OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE AND SECURITY

The Faculty of Criminal Justice and Security of the University of Maribor is Slovenia's leading educational and research institution in the field of criminal justice and security. The Faculty traces its origin to 1973, when an Internal Affairs Department was set up at the College of Public Administration in Ljubljana to meet the needs of what was then the Republic Secretariat for Internal Affairs (RSNZ) of the Socialist Republic of Slovenia. In 1981 the RSNZ replaced this department with the School of Internal Affairs in Ljubljana, which became a member institution of the University of Ljubljana that same year and remained an associate member for many years. In 1996 it was renamed the College of Police and Security Studies. In 2003 it became the Faculty of Police and Security Studies and became a member institution of the University of Maribor. It got its present name – the Faculty of Criminal Justice and Security – in 2006.

The Faculty has been involved in education and research in the field of criminal justice and security for more than five decades. It currently offers three first-cycle study programmes, one second-cycle study programme and one third-cycle study programme.

VISOKOŠOLSKI STROKOVNI PROGRAM VARNOST IN POLICIJSKO DELO

Visokošolski strokovni program Varnost in policijsko delo razvija sposobnosti diplomantov za samostojno delo in kritičnost na področju varstvoslovja. Diplomirani varstvoslovci visokošolskega strokovnega programa imajo teoretična in praktična znanja za izvajanje zahtevnih strokovnih opravil na področju zagotavljanja varnosti in vodenje varnostnih organizacij.

VISOKOŠOLSKI STROKOVNI PROGRAM INFORMACIJSKA VARNOST

Visokošolski strokovni program Informacijska varnost razvija sposobnosti diplomantov za samostojno delo na področju informacijske varnosti. Diplomirani varstvoslovci informacijske varnosti so teoretično in praktično usposobljeni za izvajanje strokovnih, razvojnih in vodstvenih opravil na področjih informatike, informacijskih sistemov in varstvoslovja, predvsem z vidika mehanizmov zagotavljanja varnosti v informacijski družbi.

UNIVERZITETNI ŠTUDIJSKI PROGRAM VARSTVOSLOVJE

Univerzitetni študijski program Varstvoslovje je raziskovalno usmerjen in poleg posredovanja ustreznih znanj razvija tudi sposobnosti diplomantov za samostojno strokovno delo, kritičnost ter analitičen, ustvarjalen in inovativen pristop k reševanju problemov. Univerzitetni diplomirani varstvoslovci so usposobljeni za prenos in uporabo teoretičnega znanja v prakso ter reševanje strokovnih delovnih problemov, zlasti z iskanjem novih virov znanja in uporabo metod za razumevanje, vodenje in upravljanje zahtevnejših procesov na področju zagotavljanja varnosti. Še posebej so opremljeni z znanji, potrebnimi za nadaljevanje študija na magistrskem programu.

UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMMES

The basic goal of the bachelor's (first-cycle) study programmes at the Faculty of Criminal Justice and Security is to provide relevant knowledge and develop students' ability to work independently, with a critical, analytical, creative and innovative approach to addressing security problems.



APPLIED BACHELOR'S PROGRAMME IN SECURITY AND POLICING

The applied bachelor's programme in Security and Policing develops students' ability to work independently and critically in criminal justice and security. Graduates of the programme have the theoretical and practical knowledge to carry out complex professional tasks in ensuring security and manage security organisations.

APPLIED BACHELOR'S PROGRAMME IN INFORMATION SECURITY

The applied bachelor's programme in Information Security develops students' ability to work independently in information security. Graduates of the programme have the theoretical and practical skills to undertake professional, developmental and managerial tasks in information technology, information systems and criminal justice and security, above all from the point of view of mechanisms for ensuring security in the information society.

BACHELOR'S PROGRAMME IN CRIMINAL JUSTICE AND SECURITY

The bachelor's programme in Criminal Justice and Security is a research-oriented programme which, in addition to providing relevant knowledge, equips students with the skills they need to work autonomously and critically while taking an analytical, creative and innovative approach to problem-solving. Students are trained to transfer and apply theoretical knowledge in practice and to solve professional problems, in particular by looking for new sources of knowledge and using methods to understand, manage and administer complex processes in security assurance. They are also equipped with the skills necessary to continue their education at the master's level

MAGISTRSKI ŠTUDIJSKI PROGRAM VARSTVOSLOVJE

Magistrski študijski program Varstvoslovje je program druge bolonjske stopnje, ki spodbuja interdisciplinarno izobraževanje, raziskovanje in mednarodno sodelovanje v okviru treh modulov: Kriminologija in kriminalistika, Korporativna varnost in Informacijska varnost. Cilj magistrskega študija je izobraziti strokovnjake z znanjem s širšega področja varstvoslovja in dobrim razumevanjem družbene realnosti, trendov na področju izvajanja nadzorstvenih dejavnosti ter delovanja institucij formalnega in neformalnega družbenega nadzorstva. Magistri varstvoslovja so usposobljeni za prevzemanje najzahtevnejših nalog pri analiziranju, vrednotenju, načrtovanju, oblikovanju, razvoju in vodenju varnostnih procesov v javnih organizacijah na državni in lokalni ravni, v nevladnih, zasebnih (gospodarskih) organizacijah ter za delo na akademskem področju.

DOKTORSKI ŠTUDIJSKI PROGRAM VARSTVOSLOVJE

Doktorski študijski program Varstvoslovje je program tretje bolonjske stopnje, usmerjen k individualiziranemu znanstvenoraziskovalnemu delu na področju varstvoslovja. Študij in raziskovanje potekata v okviru sedmih osnovnih področij: kriminologija, policijska dejavnost, kriminalistika, varnostne vede, informacijska varnost, forenzična psihologija in pravni vidiki formalnega družbenega nadzorstva.

Ključna je usmerjenost doktorskega študenta v določen raziskovalni problem znotraj omenjenih področij, pri čemer je program znan po svoji interdisciplinarnosti. Tako študenti že od vsega začetka tesno sodelujejo z mentorji, ki jih vodijo in usmerjajo pri raziskovanju.

Doktorji znanosti s področja varstvoslovja so usposobljeni za striktno uporabo ustreznega znanstvenoraziskovalnega instrumentarija za razvijanje novega znanja, ki naj prispeva k reševanju kompleksnih varnostnih in drugih problemov v družbi. Hkrati so opolnomočeni za opravljanje najzahtevnejših nalog v javnem in zasebnem sektorju, s poudarkom na zakonitosti, osebni odgovornosti, etiki in integriteti.

MASTER'S PROGRAMME IN CRIMINAL JUSTICE AND SECURITY

The master's programme Criminal Justice and Security is a second-cycle programme that promotes interdisciplinary education, research, and international cooperation in three modules: Criminology and Criminal Justice, Corporate Security, and Information Security. The aim of the master's programme is to educate experts with a broad knowledge of criminal justice and security and a sound understanding of social reality, trends in the implementation of control activities and the functioning of institutions of formal and informal social control. Students are qualified to perform the most demanding tasks in the analysis, evaluation, planning, design, development and management of security processes in public organisations at the national and local levels and in non-governmental, private (business) organisations, as well as for work in academia.

DOCTORAL PROGRAMME IN CRIMINAL JUSTICE AND SECURITY

The doctoral programme in Criminal Justice and Security is a third-cycle programme focused on individual research in criminal justice and security. The programme and research activities take place in seven basic fields: criminology, policing, criminal investigation, security studies, information security, forensic psychology and legal aspects of formal social control. A key aspect of the programme, which is characterised by its interdisciplinary nature, is the doctoral student's focus on a specific research problem within these fields. From the very beginning, students work closely with their supervisors, who lead and guide them in their research. Graduates of the doctoral programme are trained in the strict application of the appropriate research tools to develop new knowledge that can contribute to the resolution of complex security issues and other problems in society. At the same time, they are equipped to carry out the most demanding tasks in the public and private sectors, with an emphasis on legality, personal responsibility, ethics and integrity.

RAZISKOVALNA DEJAVNOST

Na Fakulteti za varnostne vede pedagoško in raziskovalno dejavnost razumemo kot enakovredna procesa, s katerima dosegamo sinergijske učinke. Poslanstvo univerze je namreč ustvarjanje in posredovanje novega znanja, kar je mogoče le z intenzivnim znanstvenoraziskovalnim delom. Raziskovalna dejavnost fakultete obsega raziskave s področja varnostnih ved, ki se nanašajo na širok spekter tematik, kot so npr. kriminaliteta, kriminalistika, varnostni menedžment, pravo, informacijska varnost, psihologija, sociologija, policijska dejavnost. V raziskovalno delo fakultete so v veliki meri v okviru notranjih projektov fakultete in zaključnih del vključeni tudi študenti, še posebej pa to velja za doktorske študente. Naši raziskovalci ugotovitve in rezultate svojega raziskovalnega dela objavljajo v uglednih domačih in tujih znanstvenih revijah in monografijah. Kot priznani strokovnjaki s področja varnostnih ved se udeležujejo številnih domačih in tujih znanstvenih srečanj, so dejavnici v domačih in mednarodnih znanstvenih ter strokovnih združenjih in predstavljajo svoje izsledke na najuglednejših institucijah po svetu. Fakulteta za varnostne vede gradi uspešno in povezano akademsko skupnost s prenosom raziskovalnih spoznanj v pedagoški proces, z dostopom do globalnih znanstvenih in strokovnih virov ter s sodelovanjem pri oblikovanju sektorskih politik.

Fakulteta za varnostne vede od leta 2015 dalje v okviru programskih skupin Varnost v lokalnih skupnostih (2015–2018) in Varnost v lokalnih skupnostih – primerjava ruralnih in urbanih okolij (2019–2024) izvaja raziskovalni program s področja zagotavljanja varnosti v slovenskih lokalnih okoljih, torej tam, kjer se kompleksnost varnosti pokaže v vsej svoji razsežnosti.

Na Fakulteti za varnostne vede deluje Inštitut za varstvoslovje, ki se posveča celovitemu varstvoslovnemu raziskovanju. Raziskovanje obsega preučevanje in razvijanje teorij, struktur, postopkov, vzrokov in posledic družbenega odzivanja na kriminaliteto in preučevanje najrazličnejših varnostnih pojavov. V okviru inštituta izvajamo domače in tuge temeljne, aplikativne, razvojne in druge projekte ter opravljamo strokovne, svetovalne in druge storitve, ki sodijo v nacionalni in mednarodni program raziskovalnega dela.

RESEARCH



We at the Faculty of Criminal Justice and Security see teaching and research as processes of equal value through which we achieve synergistic effects. The mission of a university is, after all, the creation and dissemination of new knowledge, something that is only possible through intensive research. The Faculty's research activities consist of research in the field of security studies, relating to a wide range of topics such as crime, criminal investigation, security management, law, information security, psychology, sociology and policing. Students are also involved in the Faculty's research activities, above all in the context of internal projects and final theses or dissertations. This applies in particular to doctoral students. Research at the Faculty is aimed at acquiring new knowledge, developing innovative solutions and contributing to raising the quality of the security sector, both in Slovenia and in the international environment. The Faculty of Criminal Justice and Security also cooperates with partner institutions and organisations in its research activities.

Our researchers publish the findings and results of their research in prestigious national and international scholarly journals and monographs. As recognised experts in security studies, they participate in numerous scientific conferences at home and abroad, are active in national and international scientific and professional associations and present their findings at some of the most prestigious institutions in the world. The Faculty of Criminal Justice and Security is building a successful and interconnected academic community through the transfer of research findings into the teaching process, access to global academic and professional resources and participation in the formulation of sectoral policies.

Since 2015, in the context of the programme groups Safety and Security in Local Communities (2015–2018) and Safety and Security in Local Communities – Comparison of Rural and Urban Environments (2019–2024), the Faculty of Criminal Justice and Security has been running a research programme on safety and security in local communities around Slovenia, in other words in areas where the complexity of safety and security is apparent in all its dimensions.

The Faculty of Criminal Justice and Security is also home to the Institute of Criminal Justice and Security Research, dedicated to researching every aspect of this field. Research covers the study and development of theories, structures, processes, causes and consequences of society's response to crime and the study of the widest possible range of security phenomena. The Institute runs national and international basic, applied, developmental and other projects and provides professional, consulting and other services relating to the national and international research programme.


MEDNARODNO SODELOVANJE

Fakulteta za varnostne vede tesno sodeluje s številnimi tujimi univerzami in instituti. Naši študenti odhajajo v tujino na študijske izmenjave, usposabljanja ter strokovne ekskurzije, ki so organizirane s pomočjo partnerskih institucij v tujini. Poleg omenjenih mobilnosti internacionalizacijo fakultete zaznamuje tudi vpis tujih študentov na redni in izredni študij, kar potrjuje veliko prepoznavnost in ugled fakultete v širši regiji.

Profesorji in raziskovalci Fakultete za varnostne vede svoje pedagoško in raziskovalno delo redno izvajajo tudi na sorodnih institucijah v tujini. Njihova mednarodna mobilnost in sodelovanje vključuje tedenska, mesečna in večmesečna gostovanja ter aktivno sodelovanje v mednarodnih raziskovalnih projektih. Krajsa gostovanja z namenom usposabljanja so omogočena tudi strokovnim delavcem fakultete. INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION



The Faculty of Criminal Justice and Security cooperates closely with numerous universities and institutes in other countries. The basis of international cooperation is represented by agreements with numerous prestigious European universities that facilitate student and staff mobility under the Erasmus+ programme. The Faculty has also signed other bilateral agreements and established a network of partner institutions around the world.

A well-developed network of partner institutions enables the Faculty to participate actively in student mobility programmes. We cooperate with colleagues from partner universities on joint research projects and on exchanges of students, teaching staff and support staff.

We also welcome foreign students to the Faculty through the Erasmus+ programme, giving them the opportunity to complete course units by choosing from among the many components of our study programmes that are taught in English. Our own students travel abroad on student exchanges and for training and study trips organised with the help of partner institutions in other countries. A further aspect of the internationalisation of the Faculty, in addition to the forms of mobility already mentioned, is the enrolment of foreign students in full-time and part-time courses of study, which reflects the Faculty's high profile and prestige in the wider region.

The teaching staff and researchers of the Faculty of Criminal Justice and Security regularly teach and conduct research at related institutions abroad. Their international mobility and cooperation includes visiting lectureships and professorships lasting a week, a month or several months, and active participation in international research projects. Brief visits to foreign institutions for training purposes are also available to the Faculty's support staff. The Faculty regularly hosts distinguished professors, researchers and industry experts from abroad, who share the latest discoveries and experiences with our students.

Večkrat na leto so organizirane tudi Kriminalistične srede, strokovna srečanja, namenjena strokovni pa tudi laični javnosti.





EVENTS AT THE FACULTY

The Faculty of Criminal Justice and Security organises a range of academic and professional conferences and other events, either independently or in cooperation with other institutions in Slovenia or abroad. Our traditional conferences include:

- *Criminal Justice and Security Days (Slovenia's most important annual security conference);*
- *Criminal Justice and Security in Central and Eastern Europe (international biennial conference);*
- *A conference on information security.*

Criminal Investigation Wednesdays – meetings aimed at the professional community and the general public – also take place several times a year.

Pri zagotavljanju storitev za uporabnike je še posebej pomembno povezovanje z Univerzitetno knjižnico Maribor ter knjižnicami drugih fakultet Univerze v Mariboru, saj le te svojim uporabnikom skupaj zagotavljajo dostop do velikega števila domačih in tujih elektronskih informacijskih virov. Knjižnica izvaja tudi informacijsko opismenjevanje študentov in je vključena v procese založniške dejavnosti na fakulteti.





PUBLISHING ACTIVITIES AND LIBRARY

Publishing activities at the Faculty of Criminal Justice and Security are among the principal support functions that complement the Faculty's educational and research activities. High-quality study materials are a prerequisite for good teaching and learning, while the dissemination of new knowledge and ideas through a variety of publications provides a basis for study and research. The Faculty's publishing activities help us develop the field of criminal justice and security studies and increase the quality of the educational process. The publications of the Faculty of Criminal Justice and Security, which include textbooks, monographs, collections of papers and serial publications, are intended for students and graduates of the Faculty and the general professional public.

The library of the Faculty of Criminal Justice and Security acquires, processes, stores and provides access to materials from the wider field of criminal justice and security and related disciplines, in this way providing important support for the Faculty's teaching and research work. The library also collaborates with libraries at other higher education institutions and specialised libraries. Through its connections with Maribor University Library and other faculty libraries, it is able to provide users with access to a large number of Slovenian and foreign electronic information sources. The library also provides students with training in information literacy skills and is involved in publishing activities at the Faculty.



SLOVENIJA

Republika Slovenija obsega 20.271 km² površine, ki jo poseljujeta dobra dva milijona prebivalcev, med katerimi so večinoma Slovenci, priznani pa sta tudi dve avtohtoni nacionalni manjšini – italijanska in madžarska narodna skupnost. Od leta 2004 je Slovenija članica Evropske unije in Nata, plačilno sredstvo pa je evro. Na njenem ozemlju se stikajo štiri velika geografska območja: Alpe, Panonska nižina, Dinarsko gorstvo in Sredozemlje. Več kot polovico Slovenije pokriva gozd, kar jo uvršča na tretje mesto med najbolj gozdnatimi državami v Evropi. Približno 14 odstotkov njenega ozemlja je zavarovanega. Najpomembnejša zavarovana območja so Triglavski narodni park, Škocjanske jame, Sečoveljske soline, Cerkniško jezero in Škocjanski zatok. Naravne danosti, prijazni prebivalci, mirno in varno okolje privabijo v Slovenijo vsako leto več obiskovalcev iz tujine. Razdalje med kraji so kratke, cestna infrastruktura pa razvita, kar omogoča ogled pestre palete naravnih, kulturnih, arhitekturnih, etnografskih in drugih znamenitosti in značilnosti v relativno kratkem času.



SLOVENIA

Slovenia has an area of 20,271 km² and a population of just over two million, most of whom are ethnic Slovenes. The country's Italian and Hungarian communities are recognised as national minorities. Slovenia has been a member of the European Union and NATO since 2004 and its currency is the euro. Four large geographical areas meet in Slovenian territory: the Alps, the Pannonian Basin, the Dinaric Alps and the Mediterranean. More than half of Slovenia is covered by forest, making it the third most forested country in Europe. Approximately 14% of its territory is protected, and among the most important protected areas are Triglav National Park, the Škocjan Caves, the Sečovlje Salina Nature Park, Lake Cerknica, and the Škocjanski Zatok Nature Reserve. Natural conditions, friendly people, and a peaceful and safe environment attract a growing number of visitors from abroad each year. Distances between towns are short and road infrastructure is well developed, allowing visitors to see a wide range of natural, cultural, architectural and other sights and features in a relatively short time.





LJUBLJANA

Ljubljana je glavno in s približno 293.220 prebivalci tudi največje mesto v Sloveniji. Po številu prebivalcev se uvršča med srednje velika evropska mesta. Ob tem, ko ohranja toplino in prijaznost, tako značilni za manjše kraje, ima vse, kar premorejo velike prestolnice – je politično, gospodarsko, kulturno, izobraževalno in znanstveno središče Slovenije ter pomembno trgovsko, poslovno, kongresno in sejemsко mesto na stičišču Srednje in Jugovzhodne Evrope. Ljubljana je mesto različnih kultur in zgodovinskih dogajanj. Njena podoba je slikovita, poseben čar mestu pa dajejo številne zelene površine, zaradi katerih Ljubljano uvriščajo med najbolj zelena mesta v Evropi. Staro mestno jedro krasí izjemna arhitektura, ki so jo zaznamovala različna zgodovinska obdobja, še najbolj pa barok. Poseben pečat je mestu vtisnil znameniti arhitekt Jože Plečnik (1872–1957). Ljubljana nudi številne kulturne in umetniške dogodke. Koncerti, festivali, gledališke predstave, operni in baletni program, ulično gledališče, sejmi in različne razstave gostijo priznane domače in tuje umetnike.



LJUBLJANA

Ljubljana is Slovenia's capital and, with just over 293,000 inhabitants, the country's largest city. In terms of population, it is a medium-sized European city. While maintaining the warmth and friendliness typical of smaller towns, it has everything that large capitals possess: it is the political, economic, cultural, educational and scientific centre of Slovenia and an important commercial, business, conference and exhibition hub at the intersection of central and south-eastern Europe. Ljubljana is a city of diverse cultures and a rich history. It is also a picturesque city that is lent a special charm by its many green spaces, which make Ljubljana one of the greenest cities in Europe. Ljubljana's Old Town is graced by stunning architecture from various periods, most notably the baroque. The renowned architect Jože Plečnik (1872–1957) left his own special mark on the city. Ljubljana offers a wealth of cultural and artistic events including concerts, festivals, theatre, opera, ballet, street theatre, trade fairs and exhibitions featuring renowned national and international artists.


